SUBJECT: Freedom of Information Act Savannah River Operations Office SRO-2017-00202-F

This letter constitutes our final response to your November 14, 2016 FOIA request for (1) all documents and reports, and attachments, pertaining to drone overflight of SRS during 2016; (2) all photos taken of drones over SRS during 2016; and (3) all documents, reports, and analyses about the legality of drone overflight of SRS.

The enclosed documents are responsive to your request. Included in the documents are (1) UAS Reported Sightings on SRS Summary, (2) UAS Reports from Centerra, and (3) photos applicable to your request. However, U.S. Department of Energy Savannah River Operations Office (DOE-SR) is withholding information in part that is blacked out under Exemptions 6 and 7(f) of the FOIA.

Exemption 6 allows an agency to withhold "personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The phrase "similar files" covers any agency records containing information about a particular individual that can be identified as applying to that individual. See *United States Department of State v. Washington Post Co.*, 456 U.S. 595, 602 (1982). To determine whether releasing records containing information about a particular individual would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, we are required to balance the privacy interest that would be affected by disclosure against any public interest in the information.

The information that has been withheld under Exemption 6 consists of personal information, including names, home addresses, telephone numbers, and badge numbers of witnesses, and we have determined that the individuals to whom this information pertains have a substantial privacy interest in withholding it. In applying Exemption 6, the Department of Energy Savannah River Operations Office (DOE-SR) considered (1) whether a significant privacy interest would be invaded; (2) whether release of the information would further the public interest by shedding light on the operations or activities of the government; and (3) whether in balancing the privacy interest against the public interest, disclosure would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of privacy. DOE balanced the public interest in disclosure against the privacy interest of the individuals involved and concluded that the public interest in disclosure did not outweigh the adverse impact of disclosure on the individuals. There is little or no public interest in the information withheld from the enclosed documents. All other information within the documents, not withheld as explained above, is being provided to you in its entirety.

Exemption 7(f) allows withholding law enforcement files or other information if their release could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual. For the

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
materials that have been withheld under 7(f), we have determined releasing them could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of an individual because disclosure would compromise the protection of our facilities and the individuals employed to protect them.

If you wish to challenge the adequacy of the search or the information withheld, you must submit a written appeal within 90 calendar days after receipt of this letter denying in part and granting in part the requested information. Written appeals should be submitted to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, L'Enfant Plaza Building, Washington, DC 20585, under 10 CFR § 1004.8, which sets forth the required elements of such appeals. Thereafter, judicial review will be available within the district in which a requester resides, has a principal place of business, in the place in which the records are situated, or in the District of Columbia. You may also submit your appeal by e-mail to OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov, including the phrase "FOIA Appeal" in the subject line.

UNMANNED AERIAL SYSTEM (UAS) REPORTED SIGHTINGS ON SRS

- #1 **Date/Time:** June 19, 2016 /1501 hours
Witnesses: (b) (6)
Initial location: (b) (7)(F)
UAS Description: 3 to 4 feet long, black
UAS Direction of Travel: Hovering over a sensitive area at low altitude (300-400 feet) and drifting from left to right slowly heading from (b) (7)(F) toward 6 o'clock of (b) (7)(F) area.
Summary of Search: Security Alert initiated at 1524 hrs. LE units conducted ground searches within (b) (7)(F) H, L, Central Shops, (b) (7)(F) Hwy 125 and surrounding area. DOE Helicopter (N116SR) was launched at 1538 hrs., circled (b) (7)(F) minutes and then proceeded to fly over Areas L, H, E, F, C A, B and Central Shops. The helicopter made one more pass over (b) (7)(F) and then returned to base. Neither LE nor AOD personnel made visual contact with the reported UAS. Security Alert was terminated at 1627 hrs.
- #2 **Date/Time:** June 22, 2016/0710 hours
Witnesses: (b) (6)
Initial location: B-Area
UAS Description: 2-3 feet long, quad motor, black
UAS Direction of Travel: Crossing SC Hwy 125 at Mile Marker 2 traveling east towards B-Area at a high rate of speed approximately 50-100 feet above the tree line.
Summary of Search: Security Alert initiated at 0729 hours. DOE Helicopter was launched at 0734 hours and conducted a search of the site. LE was dispatched to check critical areas and site perimeters for possible operators. There were no other sightings observed and neither LE nor AOD personnel made visual contact with the reported UAS. Security Alert was terminated at 0750 hours.
- #3 **Date/Time:** June 23, 2016/0715 hours
Witness: (b) (6)
Initial location: MOX (Building 706-3F)
UAS Description: Single, front mounted propeller, 3-4 feet long with a 4-5 feet wingspan, white with light blue or dull yellow trim with what appeared to be a small black object under the fuselage.
UAS Direction of Travel: West to East about 50 to 75 feet above the tree line at a slow speed.
Summary of Search: Security Alert initiated at 0737 hours. Two LE Officers walked into the wooded area approximately 200 yards in search of the UAS to see if it had landed. The officers were unable to locate any evidence pertaining to the reported UAS. Security Alert was terminated at 0839 hours. (Note: DOE helicopter was not launched due to maintenance / SRS Kids Day)

- #4 **Date/Time:** Sighted: June 15, 2016/1500 hours / Reported: June 23, 2016/0820 hours
Witness: (b) (6)
Initial location: SRS Z-Area
UAS Description: Disc shape or round, white or silver and seemed to be reflective.
UAS Direction of Travel: Directly over SRS Z-Area.
Summary of Search: A search was not conducted due to the sighting being reported after the fact.
- #5 **Date/Time(s):** June 28, 2016/0743 & 0820 hours
Witnesses: (b) (6)
Initial location: SRS Road 2 and 600-E Burial Ground
UAS Description: White or Silver with fixed wings, approximately 6 to 10 feet long, 5 feet wide.
UAS Direction of Travel: Over SRS Road 2 in a West to East direction headed towards H-Area, then near the 600-E Burial Ground in a westerly direction towards 200-F Area.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 0755 hours. DOE Helicopter (N116SR) was launched at 0759 hours. AOD searched 200-H Area and made several passes between Forestry and 200-H Area, Barricades 1 & 2 and 700-A with no sightings of the UAS. LE Officers were positioned at set points on the SRS in an attempt to locate the UAS, which met with negative results. Security Alert was terminated at 0854 hours.

Initial location: SRS Road 4
UAS Description: White Quad copter approximately 1 to 1½ foot long.
UAS Direction of Travel: On SRS Road 4 in a straight line at low altitude (approximately 30 feet above the bridge) heading towards 200-H Area.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1242 hours. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate the UAS, which met with negative results. LE Officers were positioned at set points on the SRS and checked the surrounding parking lots, which also met with negative results. The UAS was not spotted again after the initial report and no identifying markings were observed on the UAS. Security Alert was terminated at 1328 hours.

Initial location: 600-B Area
UAS Description: White, fixed wing.
UAS Direction of Travel: South to north over 600-B Area.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1325 hours. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate the reported UAS, which met with negative results. Investigator Roland interviewed the witness and it was determined the aircraft was possibly used for agricultural spraying near the site. Security Alert was terminated at 1358 hours.

UAS Direction of Travel: Traveling at a high rate of speed approximately 150 feet above the trees traveling west from the direction of 200-HArea, over 200-F Area, towards 100-C Area.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1143 hours. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate the UAS, which met with negative results. Law Enforcement Officers were positioned at set points on the SRS and checked the surrounding parking lots, which also met with negative results. No identifying markings were observed on the UAS. The Security Alert was terminated at 1217 hours.

Initial location: F-Area Tank Farm
UAS Description: Small, approximately 3 feet long, winged, dark in color, solid in the middle.
UAS Direction of Travel: Over the F-Area Tank Farm fenceline
Summary of Search: Officer A. Mitchell was dispatched to Building 217-3H to meet with the witness concerning her report of a UAS sighting around the F-Tank Farm Area fenceline. The witness stated she observed the object while driving to work and did not get a close look at it because of heavy traffic in the area and could not stop. Officer Mitchell obtained a statement from the witness and an Incident Report was written.

Witness: (b) (6)
Initial location: Central Shops
UAS Description: White, fixed wing, cigar shaped plane, approximately 8-10 feet long
UAS Direction of Travel: Moving southeast to northwest at approximately 1500 – 2000 feet in the air.
Summary of Search: Law Enforcement Officer Busbee responded to Central Shops to meet with the witness about a reported UAS sighting. The witness stated he saw the object while standing in Central Shops and lost sight of the object while on the phone with LED. Officer Busbee obtained a written statement and was unable to locate the object. The on-duty LE Lieutenant deemed the object in question unlikely to be a UAS and completed an Incident Report.

Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1052 hours. The DOE-SR Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate the UAS which met with negative results. LE Officer Thigpen responded to the area and obtained written statements from all of the witnesses. LE units were in the area attempting to locate the reported UAS which also met with negative results. The Security Alert was terminated at 1133 hours.

Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1915 hours. Law Enforcement units were dispatched to the area in an effort to locate the UAS, which met with negative results. The DOE-SR Helicopter was not available for over watch at the time of this incident. LE Officer Franklin interviewed both witnesses and obtained written statements. The Security Alert was terminated at 2005 hours.

UAS Description: White with a red strip down the side, 6-8 feet long, vertical propeller at the front and rear of fuselage.

Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 0907 hours. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate the UAS, which met with negative results. Multiple Law Enforcement units were in the area attempting to locate the possible UAS, which met with negative results. The Security Alert was terminated at 0923 hours.

Witness: (b) (6)
Initial location: (b) (7)(F)
UAS Description: White with red circles in a line down the side. A propeller of any type or a cockpit was not observed.
UAS Description of Travel: Flying over the (b) (7)(F).
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1031 hours. The DOE Helicopter and multiple LE units attempted to locate and identify the UAS, which met with negative results. The Security Alert was terminated at 1045 hours.
- #15 **Date/Time:** July 22, 2016/2005 hours
Witnesses: (b) (6)
Initial location: Near Bio Mass Facility on Burma Road
UAS Description: White cylindrical object
UAS Description of Travel: South of the Bio Mass Facility traveling in a South to North direction.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 2013 hours. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate and identify the UAS, which met with negative results. Law Enforcement also conducted checks of the area which met with negative results. Bush Field was contacted and stated no other aircraft was identified over the site. No other sighting was reported and the Security Alert was terminated at 2031 hours.

Initial location: 772-1F
UAS Description: Appeared to be a tan or orange fixed-wing aircraft.

Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 1920 hours. Two Law Enforcement Officers responded to the area and obtained a written statement from the (b) (6). In addition, (b) (6) provided the officers with the video taken from his personal cell phone. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate and identify the UAS, which met with negative results. No other sighting was reported and the Security Alert was terminated at 1935 hours.

UAS Description of Travel: (b) (6) - Directly over (b) (7)(F), approximately 200-300 feet in the air, straight path towards Plant Vogtle. (b) (6) - (b) (7)(F), (b) (6) - approximately 1000 feet, a mile away from (b) (7)(F) flying over Hwy 125 at about 30 mph.
Summary of Search: Security Alert was initiated at 0948 hours. Law Enforcement Officers responded to the area and obtained written statements from the witnesses. The DOE Helicopter was launched in an effort to locate and identify the UAS which met with negative results. No other sightings were reported and the Security Alert was terminated at 1038 hours.

Initial location: J-Area (221 Building)
UAS Description: (b) (6) - tan, approximately 10 feet long. (b) (6) - light blue, approximately 40 feet long.

Summary of Search: Criminal Investigator William Smith responded to J area parking to a reported UAS sighting. As a result of interviewing both witnesses, the object was

never observed circling over the site (just flying over). The DOE-SR helicopter was not launched nor a Security Alert declared.

A check of the surrounding parking lots was conducted by Centera Law Enforcement Officers which met with negative results. The UAS was spotted again after the initial report by two other site employees: (b) (6) observed what he described as a white, fixed wing aircraft, approximately 5 foot in width, flying over 200-H Area toward 200-F area and (b) (6) reported that she observed a silver object, slightly above the tree line outside of 100-C Area. She stated she only observed it for a second, (b) (6) were all interviewed by Investigator Sharon Cornier and statements were obtained. All three individuals stated that the aircraft was traveling at a high rate of speed. No identifying markings were observed on the UAS. The Security Alert was terminated at 1217 hours.

On 9/29/16 at 0946 hours, (b) (6) reported to Savannah River Site Operations Center that he observed what he believed to be an Unmanned Aerial System flying over the (b) (7)(F). At 0948 hours, a Security Alert was initiated. At 0953 hours, Law Enforcement Officers checked roads surrounding the area. At 0957 hours, LE Officer Zach Ballentine, LE Officer James Holiday, Investigators Sharon Cormier and Will Smith arrived at (b) (7)(F). Investigator Cormier interviewed (b) (6) (b) (6) stated that at 0944 hours, he was standing between Building (b) (7)(F) and Building (b) (7)(F) when he spotted a light blue drone that was approximately 6-8 Feet long. He stated it flew over the (b) (7)(F) and went directly over (b) (7)(F) at approximately 200-300 feet in the air. He stated it flew in a straight path toward Plant Vogtle. He stated that it flew out of his site within 5 minutes. He was asked if it was fixed winged and he responded that it was. Also that the wings were at an angle and that it had a fixed tail. He stated it looked like a proto type plane. (b) (6) provided a written statement. (b) (6) was interviewed by Officer Holiday. (b) (6) stated that he observed a drone flying over (b) (7)(F) that it was light blue and it looked like one that was reported a month or so ago when he was working in Tritium. He then informed his superintendent, (b) (6). At 1015 hours, Investigator Will Smith interviewed (b) (6) (b) (6) who was working a post in the (b) (7)(F) SPO II stated he observed a silver, single manned prop plane at approximately 1000 feet elevation and a mile away from (b) (7)(F) Building. He stated he observed the air craft through binoculars and it was flying over Hwy 125, traveling at about 30MPH. There were no other sightings and the Security Alert was terminated at 1038 hours.

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NARRATIVE

On 9/28/16 at 1013 hours, Officer Derrick was dispatched to meet with (b) (6) in reference to a possible UAS sighting at MOX Facility. (b) (6) stated that she and several coworkers had witnessed an object flying over the tree line, off and on, for approximately 2 hours. Officer Derrick separated all employees and conducted field interviews and obtained witness statements. All reports were that the object appeared to be small, silver in color and not large enough to house a pilot. Witnesses also stated that the object was present when the DOE helicopters were hovering the MOX Facility. Investigators Sharon Cormier and Will Smith arrived at MOX to conduct an investigation. As interviews were being conducted, more witness continued to come forward. Before additional statements were obtained, one of the witnesses advised Officers that the object was back. Investigators Cormier and Smith with Officer Derrick observed the object and were all certain that it was a large aircraft at a high altitude and at a great distance off site. Another similar aircraft was simultaneously observed traveling in the opposite direction. Flashing, signaling marker lights could also be observed identifying it as an aircraft. The aircrafts being observed appeared to be on similar flight approaches and descents indicating possible local airfield approach routes.
