The Department of Energy’s Savannah River Site (SRS) - known as the Bomb Plant - located near Aiken, SC is a key part of the current nuclear arms race and manages some of the most dangerous radioactive waste in the U.S. DOE is now planning to build a new factory at SRS to make plutonium “pits” (cores) of new and 4000 existing nuclear warheads, a totally unnecessary project which could cost taxpayers \$18-25 billion. Yet, few know about this project, which the media won’t cover, or that new weapons production and modernization under private for-profit contractors is gobbling up the DOE budget and edging us closer to nuclear war.
