RE: Freedom of Information Act Request dated February 26, 2026

Dear Mr. Clements:

On February 28, 2026, the South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff (“ORS”) received your request pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-10 *et. seq.* (“FOIA”) in which you requested the following:

1) documentation which reveals the amount, including both capital costs and interest, of the total charges, on a total and annual basis, of abandoned nuclear project costs since January 2019 that have been passed on to all Dominion customers, and 2) a document or table reflecting the percent of the monthly bill and average monthly amount of a typical customer which can be attributed, in a periodically adjusted manner, for the terminated nuclear project since the Dominion takeover of SCE&G, for the most recent quarter for which such information exists. (A ORS document provided in response to a previous FOIA request in December 2023 indicated that 5.6% of the monthly bill for a Dominion customer could be attributed to the failed V.C. Summer nuclear project.)

As to your first request, ORS is producing certain Quarterly Financial Reports filed by Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. (“Dominion Energy”) with the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“Commission”) in Docket No. 2006-286. Additional QFRs can be accessed on the Commission’s Docket Management System at the following website:

Regarding your second request, ORS is providing a responsive document which reflects a chart showing the history of Dominion Energy’s (f/k/a South Carolina Electric & Gas Company) Rate 8.

These documents are being provided to you through a ShareFile folder. You should receive an email invitation with instructions on how to access the materials. Please note, access to the

ShareFile folder will terminate 30 days from the date of this letter. Additionally, only the following user will have access to the folder - Tomclements329@cs.com.
